Thank you for selecting this quality Griot's product. These quality frames are made from premium grade stainless steel and will provide you with years of service with proper care.


#### **USEFUL MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. When mounting this new license plate frame, please use the existing license plate mounting hardware that comes with your vehicle.
- 2. The enclosed black self-adhesive rubber spacers may be necessary on some vehicles to provide adequate clearance, and to keep the frame mounting hole tabs from bending inwards. The frame spacer acts as filler between the license plate and the panel on vehicles where a built-in spacer is not already present. Simply peel off the white paper mask on the spacer, align hole in spacer to the mounting hole on backside of the plate, and stick the adhesive side down. Referring to the diagram at right, place the clear shield on to the face of your license plate, and then place both the clear shield and license plate into the frame so that the top holes of the frame line up with the top holes of the clear shield and plate. Insert the license plate mounting screw through the frame hardware cap; with the collar around the head of the screw.
- 3. Using a screwdriver, slowly thread the screw into the mounting hole on the vehicle in a clockwise direction. Repeat this procedure for all other mounting holes.
- 4. Tighten all remaining screws until the hardware cap washer is seated firmly against the frame. Be sure not to over tighten, for this may strip the screw or the mounting holes on the vehicle. Firmly snap the matching frame hardware caps into each of the frame hardware cap washers.

  NOTE: Prior to installation, check with your local Department of Motor Vehicles for regulations governing the use of license plate frames and clear plate shields.

#### PROPER CARE AND CLEANING

Wash license plate frames and protective shield with mild soap (Griot's Garage Car Wash works perfectly) and water. Always dry with a soft micro fiber cloth. Moisture may get between the protective shield and license plate. This will evaporate over time. You may polish the stainless steel frame with



Griot's Garage Metal Polish. Use only nonabrasive polishes. Never polish with abrasives or cleaning solvents. You may clean and polish the clear protective shield with Griot's Garage Plastic Cleaner and Plastic Polish. Protect the stainless steel frame with a quality non-abrasive wax such as Griot's Garage Best of Show Wax®, Carnauba Wax, or Paint Sealant. Do not use steel wool, soap pads or other harsh detergents.
