Wash

Remove loose contaminants using a traditional hose and bucket, foaming system, rinseless, or waterless method.



Clay

Prep the surface and produce a truly clean slate by removing stubborn, embedded contaminants from your paint.



Butter

Spread product onto pad face starting at center and work to outer edge. Spread evenly with domed cap.



Polish

Place the buffing pad onto paint, set machine speed to 2, then spread product in a 2'x 2' area. Turn speed up to 3-5 for polishing.



Wipe

After polishing wipe residue away with a premium microfiber towel, turning the towel often, then buff to a brilliant luster.





Polishing Tips

- First do no harm. Always use the least invasive method first. Test method in 1'x1' area and adjust approach if necessary.
- Dedicate your pads. Don't apply wax to a pad you've polished with.
- Butter entire pad face prior to application using domed cap. Reapply using 3 or 4 opposing drops on each subsequent panel.
- Set appropriate machine speed per reference chart.
- Place cord over your shoulder to avoid contact with paint surface.
- Always start and stop machine with pad resting on the surface.
- Keeping pad flat to the surface, work in 2'x 2' sections. Let each panel be your guide.



- Apply using overlapping, light-pressure passes with steady arm speed.
- Frequently clean pad by running it against a Foam Pad Conditioning Brush or towel.

Compound & Polishing

Work one section at a time, then remove residue immediately by hand using a microfiber towel.

Waxing & Sealing

Apply a thin, even layer to entire vehicle. Allow residue to dry to a haze or wait 20-30 minutes then wipe clean with a premium microfiber towel.

Pad Maintenance

Following work, rinse pads thoroughly with hot water, treat with Microfiber & Foam Pad Cleaner, allow to dwell, rinse thoroughly, and air dry.
